### ARAVALI'S STRATEGIC AREA OF WORK

**Collaboration support :** Facilitate building partnership and convergence with Community-based Organisations, NGOs, Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), Panchayati Raj Institutions and Government Departments; undertaking Decentralised Planning Process (including GPDP), Child Friendly Panchayat.

**Human and Institutional Capacity Enhancement :** Capacity enhancement of NGOs (Organisational Development and System & Process), Training and Capacity enhancement of human resource (Govt., CSOs, CSR and Development Organisations).

**Action Research and Knowledge Generation :** Undertaking field demonstrations, Research Studies, Impact Assessment & Evaluation, Rapid Feedback Assessment of Programme / Projects / Schemes, Concurrent Monitoring, Documentation of best practices and Training Manual preparation.

**Innovations for Livelihood Promotion :** Working with the poorest through Family Livelihood Resource Centre, Farmer Field School approach, Local Livelihood Facilitators, Promoting Farmer's Producer Organisations, Occupational Health and Safety and Protection of Child Rights.

**OUR MISSION :** Within this context, ARAVALI intends to ensure that there are an increased number of effective voluntary organisations working closely with marginalized communities in every district of Rajasthan and that an enabling environment is developed within which the government and these organisations can form effective partnerships.
